Eligibility: Applicant must currently be a high school junior or senior and must be a current active USBC Youth member in good standing in a SE MN USBC-affiliated bowling program. Applicant can not have competed in a professional bowling tournament (Pro-AM's excluded).

Instructions for Completion and Submission of the SE MN USBC CARES Scholarship Application

Youth Bowler is to complete the 2-page scholarship application form and have it signed by a parent or guardian if the applicant is under 18 years of age at the time of submission. Applicant also must obtain the signature of a youth bowling coach or center coordinator from the active program to which they belong. All areas of the application must be completed to be considered for review. Completed application must be postmarked **no later than March 1, 2010** to the address on the bottom of the application form.

Coach Evaluation Form should be given to the coach/coordinator with a stamped pre-addressed envelope in which they can submit the evaluation upon its completion directly to the address on the bottom of the evaluation form. This evaluation should be mailed separately from the bowler's application form, and **postmarked no later than March 1, 2010**.
